# 15 documentaries celebrate ltalian cinema behind the scenes

"Oltre lo schermo" takes the audience on an exciting journey through Italian and international film production of the last 70 years to discover the hidden universe behind the scenes. 15 films explore the most famous sets, alongside the most famous directors - from Luchino Visconti to Lina Wertmüller, from Francesco Rosi to Giuliano Montaldo - also revealing roles and professionals without whom the magic of cinema would be impossible, today as in the past.

The collection includes Oscar winners such as set designer **Dante Ferretti** and maestro **Nino Rota**, composer of celebrated music. We will see stagehands, seamstresses, carpenters, painters and sculptors at work, reigning masters among the warehouses and workshops of Cinecittà and artists who have dedicated their lives to designing the billboards of films, such as **Silvano Campeggi**, who flew to Los Angeles to depict legendary **Marilyn Monroe**. We will hear **Giuliano Montaldo** recount the genesis of *Sacco and Vanzetti*, among difficulties and incredible twists such as the meeting of **Joan Baez** and **Ennio Morricone** who in only a few hours recorded *Here's to You*, the ballad that has become the manifesto of an entire generation.

We will have a chance to take a close look at the turbulent bond of friendship and esteem that connected Federico Fellini and Ennio Flaiano, or meet Piero Tosi, who dressed the greatest divas of all time, from Claudia Cardinale to Silvana Mangano. We will discover the legendary director of photography and director Carlo Di Palma through anecdotes, comments and reflections of the most prestigious figures of worldwide cinema. And we will be captivated by the sequence of testimonies collected by Giuseppe Tornatore in the exciting documentary on Goffredo Lombardo, the producer who with the production house Titanus completely redesigned the Italian cinema of the second half of the 20th century. We will be able to immerse ourselves in one of the most lucid analyses of the history of Italy through Francesco Rosi's civil cinema, get to know Alida Valli, the mother of all actresses according to Giuseppe Bertolucci, or learn the surprising story of Panaria Film through the story of Francesco Alliata, one of the founders of the small Sicilian production house at the centre of the most famous postwar film scandal between Hollywood, Rome and the Aeolian Islands: the famous war of the volcanoes and its divine protagonists Roberto Rossellini, Anna Magnani and Ingrid Bergman. A roundup of portraits that are a hymn to the beauty, wealth, strength, the determination of cinema, of the men and women who made it and all those who loved and continue to love it.

The protagonists recounted in the collection are united by the same passion, attitude, creativity, spirit of initiative and experience in the field. Not just actors, directors and screenwriters, but also cinematographers, composers, costume designers, set designers, artisans and producers: a wealth of skills and professionalism that has made **Italian film production an extraordinary excellence recognised worldwide over the years**.





Francesco Rosi invented a new narrative style for a type of cinema that did not exist before him. His films arose from research and inquiries on the country's reality: he worked on documents, on "what was known". He discussed the "power" that corrupts and is corrupted when mixed with crime. The story unfolds through his films lined up not in the order in which they were shot, but based on the historical importance of the events they retrace.





SYNOPSIS March 1964. Angelo Rizzoli, Federico Fellini and Giulietta Masina, along with the actors,

screenwriters and technicians forming the cast of 8 1/2 are on their way to Los Angeles.

Destination: Oscar night. During their layover in New York, Ennio Flaiano, Fellini's companion in film adventures for over 20 years, decides to go back to Rome. This decision becomes the starting point of the documentary that investigates the depth of Flaiano's contribution to cinema, retracing the life and works of one of the most fruitful, original and sensitive figures of postwar Italian culture.







#### As Time Goes By L' uomo che disegnava sogni

> The memories of Silvano Campeggi, the artist behind the portraits of the stars of the 1950s responsible for the posters of the most famous Hollywood films.

Professionally known as Nano, Silvano Campeggi illustrated the dreams of Italians after the war and up to the 1960s: he is responsible for the film posters of Gone with the Wind, Casablanca, Ben Hur and thousands of other films. Born in Florence in 1923, he has spanned a century: what for most of us are black and white images - the carriages under Palazzo Vecchio, the liberation of Florence, the arrival of American stars in Rome in the period of Hollywood sul Tevere -, are vivid and colourful memories for him, just like the drawings he continues to make while whistling songs and thinking back to that time when Marilyn asked him: "Maestro, should I take my clothes off?".
